BILL BOLTON

Bill, former editor of the National Recruiting Men's & Women's Profile Publications, the nation's most informative recruiting profile service. Bill, known for his ability to develop pivot play and authored numerous articles in Scholastic Coach, Athletic Journal, Coach & Athlete, and he was chronicled in many publications such as Sports Illustrated, The Recruiting of Marcus Dupree by Willie Morris, Indiana Hoosiers by Phillip M. Hoose, etc. He starred for the University of Mississippi for (4) years and ranked in the top ten in rebounding and shooting and still appears in the record books. He was a successful coach at Stetson University and won the Mid-East Regional Championship (College Division); then at Ole Miss he recruited Johnny Neuman, the nation's leading scorer and at Florida State University his recruiting expertise helped FSU reach the final game of the National Championship against John Wooden's UCLA Bruins. That championship game was the highest rated telecast in NCAA history at that time. On the Road to the Final Four FSU also defeated Kentucky to win the Mid-East Regional Championship - the last game of Coach Adolph Rupp's lustrous career - the nation's winningest coach. Bill represented Converse Rubber Co. in Sales & Promotion. He worked with college, pro teams and the widely popular and televised ABC SPORTS SUPERSTAR CONTEST in the Grand Bahama Islands.

BILL CRONAUER

Bill, former editor of the B/C Scouting Service, was the nation's foremost high school and junior college talent-searching organization based in St. Petersburg FL.

Bill graduated from Syracuse University. He viewed more than 200 games a year and served on the advisory and selection committees for most of the post-season all-star games, including the prestigious McDonald's All-American Classic. His men's and women's prep All-American teams ranked #1 in the U. S. Bill, a former sportswriter for the St. Petersburg Times, also was a frequent participant on recruiting-oriented radio talk shows nationwide.
